



JOB TITLE: ONE TO ONE INSTRUCTIONAL AIDE

Reports to: Classroom Teacher

Part-time, Non-Exempt Position

JOB PURPOSE:

The 1:1 Instructional Aide provides individual support four to five mornings a week to a student who is deaf/hard of hearing with additional special needs.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The 1:1 Instructional Aide facilitates the child's access to and participation in the classroom, playground and all school activities. In addition to supporting basic needs of the student, the Aide works with the student to increase communication in sign language, speech, or other alternative methods. The Aide helps the student increase motor development skill and function more independently and safely engage in the educational environment. The Aide works cooperatively with the teacher and other classroom staff.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Work with student individually and in small group settings
- Provide student with daily opportunities to increase communication skills and improve motor development and ambulatory skills
- Support transitions from activity to activity with attention to proper seating and positioning
- Assist with self care needs including diaper changes, toileting, hand washing, feeding etc.
- Keep records of student's progress
- Provide teacher with regular feedback about student progress
- Work cooperatively with teacher, speech therapist, consultants, and other staff
- Attend meetings and inservice trainings as necessary
- Maintain dependable attendance

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Required

- Early childhood education and/or child development coursework or related field
- Strong, effective interpersonal communication skills, initiative in engaging children in activities, ability to life small children, capable of identifying and monitoring special needs of children
- Skill in sign language preferred; knowledge of typical child development and the importance of play, knowledge of special needs and competency working with diverse families

Desirable

- Experience with deaf culture and history of deaf education
- Knowledge of adaptive equipment and community resources for children with multiple special needs
- Spanish language fluency

SALARY AND BENEFITS
