Education Specialist- Deaf and Hard of Hearing

Looking for educators to provide an individualized educational program for deaf and hard of hearing pupils with special emphasis on academic, social and overall language development. Instruction must follow evidence-based best practices for deaf and hard of hearing students as language learners, using multi-modal total communication teaching strategies (i.e. American Sign Language, auditory training, multi-sensory training). Must have an openness to a range of communication needs/preferences.

School Counselor - Deaf and Hard of Hearing

Counsels students, parents and teachers individually or in groups on educational, career, and personal-social matters in order to maximize students' educational opportunities. Assists pupils in defining long-range and short-range educational goals and collaborates with teachers and staff regarding program planning (class scheduling); assists in arranging the programs; ensures that pupils receive supports in the areas of academics, social emotional well-being and college and career readiness; coordinates with outside agencies to provide resources and supports to families and students; assists with providing transition plans between grade levels and into the middle school for clear articulation and matriculation.

Qualifications: Bachelor Degree, passing CBEST Score and Deaf and Hard of Hearing Credential (Teacher) or PPS Credential (School Counselor) required. Must verify or be eligible to verify NCLB compliance upon entering the position. Fluency in American Sign Language preferred but not required depending on site and/or population served.
