

TALK ASL Part-Time Teaching Positions:

TALK (Teach Another Language to Kids) is a small, parent-run non-profit that provides foreign language classes to elementary school children in Davis. This past year, we added ASL to our class offerings.

We require our teachers be fluent in ASL, with a strong desire to work with kids. We seek candidates who have experience with kids, and are punctual and creative. Once hired, teachers will also be given a background check.

This school year we will offer ASL classes at two locations in Davis. Classes will begin September 14 and end May 27, with breaks for holidays and winter and spring breaks.

ASL classes at St James School (1275 B Street) will be Monday-Friday from 7:40 am to 8:10 am. A new ASL class will be added at Fairfield Elementary (26960 County Road 96), Monday-Thursday from 7:50 am to 8:20 am.

The work amounts to about one hour per day, 4 or 5 hours total per week, with regular teacher meetings in addition to that. Each class is counted as a full hour to account for class preparation, plus walking kids to campus (some kids attend North Davis Elementary, and are walked a block to their campus immediately after ASL class at St James). The hourly pay rate is \$13/hour. Teacher meetings, trainings or events are also paid time.
